
Central Linn Choir Curriculum Map



Junior High Choir is a training choir that is intended to be taken for two years. This will help fully develop beginning singing skills as well as music reading and music theory knowledge that is needed in more advanced groups. *This class has low outside commitments, with 4 concerts a year.*

Treble Choir (formerly Girls' Choir) is a second step training choir for students desiring to move on to Blue Notes or for Blue Notes members wanting to increase their vocal range and experience other styles of music. It is also an option for high school treble voices wanting to continue in choir but not follow the busy schedule that Blue Notes usually has. This is also a training choir for beginning High School singers. *This group has 4 concerts a year, one to two field trips and one to two additional concerts as needed.*

Blue Notes is an advanced choir for SATB voices. Previous choir experience is required and an audition is needed in order to be recommended for the class (spring of 2021 is the exception due to COVID). This group sings in multiple concerts a year, travels to other states and competes in multiple jazz competitions during the school year. We participate in extensive fundraising projects and community outreach when possible. The main style performed and studied is Jazz, with a mix of other styles when appropriate. Blue Notes is an award winning group that demands a high level of dedication and focused rehearsal time.
