



## Full In-Person Learning Option

**Overview :** Students in this option will come to CLSDS in-person, every regular school day with additional precautionary measures and procedures in place. The school schedule will shift from a "Semester 7 Period Day" to a "Trimester 5 Period Day" to meet cohorting requirements and provide students a smaller course load if a transition to Learn at Home is necessary. In addition, all courses will simultaneously be provided through Google Classroom, in order to provide a seamless transition to a Learning at Home model if necessary.

**Point Person :** Regular CLSD staff will coordinate student coursework and services.

### Curriculum:

- Regular Teacher-Designed In-Person Class Curriculum
- Dual Credit High School and College Credit courses available in Math, Writing, History, Science, Health, and Psychology

### Additional Resources:

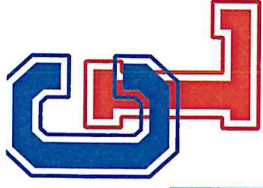
- Each student will have a Chromebook with Tech Support
- In-person meals at school in designated locations
- Full IEP, Mental Health, and Academic Support Services
- Daily In-Person Interaction with Teachers & Peers
- In-Person Interactive Electives (Agriculture, Band, Choir, AVID, Photography, Weights, etc.)

### Transportation Option:

- Transportation provided to and from school when needed

### In Case of Mandated School Closure:

- In-person classes will transition to a "Learning at Home" model with teachers providing instruction daily.
- A Chromebook will be assigned to each student for the school year
- Meal service will be delivered through bus routes.

**All 7th and 8th Graders will have all of their In-Person core courses in the new Junior High Building.**

**Overview:** Students in this option will work completely from home while receiving resources, coordination, and support services from CLSD staff members. Students will follow daily schedule of classes, just as if they were on campus. Students will receive a full 5 class schedule, and will be on the district trimester schedule for grading.
