The CLEA Scholarship is open to students graduating in this June or who have previously graduated from Central Linn High School with a 3.0 or higher GPA (Post Graduates need a 2.5 or higher GPA). Scholarships, totaling \$1500, will be given to applicants at the discretion of the selection committee.

- Applicants must have been accepted to a post-high school institution with the intent to earn a degree in a field of study providing a social service, such as health care, education, social work, legal services, or community work.
- Applicants must submit two recommendations from any current or previous teachers, church, or community members.
- Applicants must complete a typed, double-spaced essay, not to exceed two pages, explaining their goals in their chosen field of study.
- Applicants must designate the post-high school institution to which they have been accepted and are (or are planning on) attending.
- Proof of acceptance (a copy is acceptable) at a post-high school institution must be received prior to disbursement of an award. (If you are a post-graduate and are already attending a post-high school institution, please also include last year's transcripts for proof of a 2.5 or higher GPA.) Disbursement will be placed directly into your student account at the school.
- Applicants must agree to an oral interview, if asked, by the CLEA selection committee. During this interview, applicants will be asked to share how their high school record, activities, community service, and family commitment supports the intended field of study and the goals they have set.
- Applicants must include a cover letter, with complete contact information.
