Attendance is very important! Our school wide goal is 96% student attendance.

Our school wide attendance to date is 88.39%.

Any student under 90% may receive an attendance letter. We understand that kids get sick and sometimes miss school for very real reasons. If your child is sick, has a fever, and may be contagious to other students, please keep them home from school. If your student misses more than three consecutive days, please provide a doctor's note. If your child misses school for a medical / dental appointment, please provide the office with a note from the provider.
