Dear Parent/guardian,

In an effort to help you and your student/s understand what a complete, reimbursable meal looks like (reimbursable meaning the school gets a portion of that meal reimbursed by the state), and to help avoid extra food charges, we would love to share with you these infographics that can help you to better understand the breakfast and lunch program here at Central Linn. We encourage you to look over the infographics with your student/s and work with them on how to build a healthy, full, and complete breakfast and lunch meal. As you can see in the infographics, both breakfast and lunch are made up of 5 food components: Grains, Meat/Meat Alternative, Fruit, Vegetables, and Milk. Students must choose at least 3 of the 5 components and one of those choices must be a minimum 1/2 cup fruit and/or juice for breakfast and a minimum 1/2 cup fruit and/or vegetable for lunch. If students do not take the minimum required 3 out of 5 components, including the required fruit/juice/vegetable component, they will be charged for each item individually, regardless of eligibility in the free and reduced program. As per Federal and State regulations, we cannot charge the meal as complete and reimbursable if those required components are not chosen by your student at breakfast and lunch. Thank you for your help and understanding in this matter.
