## Meal Charges for the Elementary:

Breakfast - \$1.70

Lunch – \$2.80

Milk - .50 cents

If you get just a milk, it is 50 cents. Milk is included in the meal however; by itself, there is a charge that is not covered by the free and reduced lunch program.

**Children who read at least 20 minutes a day are exposed to almost 2 million words per year.**

In contrast, kids who read at home for five minutes a day will hear only 282,000 words per year. That is not all. Kids who engage in reading 20 minutes a day, statistics show, are likely to score better than 90% of their peers on standardized tests. (Every Child Reads)

### For the week of September 19.

- **Single lane closures on the south end of town 7 am – 2 pm Monday and Tuesday. Flaggers will be out controlling traffic.**

- **Swale- landscaping the swale near the school 9/22 and 9/23. Expect minimal impact.**
