Background Checks required for everyone, every year!

All volunteers must have a background check. Forms can be picked up or requested to send home with a student from the Office. Background checks must be approved before volunteering at the school or going on field trips.

We are now offering Before and After childcare for our elementary students. Before school starting from 7am to 7:45am and after school from 3:20pm to 5pm. Information is being sent home this week. Any questions please call the office and ask for Sandy Brown @ 541-369-2851.

School begins at 8:00am. Dismissal is at 3:20pm.

- Morning drop off time is no earlier than 7:45am. Breakfast is served in the cafeteria from 7:45am to 8:05am. Students are considered tardy after 8:10am.
- **If your child rides the bus....** Your child will go either to Breakfast or directly to the classroom after arriving at school. At the end of the day, Staff will escort students to load the bus and depart CLES by 3:25pm.
- **If your child is a walker...** Your child will be escorted out of the building and lead to one of three crosswalks. They will be assisted across the crosswalk by a staff member.
- **If you drop off/ pick up your child...** **NEW – Drop off / Pickup**
- Please enter the parking lot from W 2nd Street, drive into the area that used to be parking closest to the building. Pull up to the second crosswalk or as far forward as possible. Pick up or drop of child then proceed to exit the lot. Please, right turn only on to West C street so as to avoid backing up the line as people wait to turn on to W 2nd Street.
- Please do not drop off before 7:45am.Pick up will start at 3:25pm.
