

Corporal Punishment

The use of corporal punishment in any form is strictly prohibited at the schools, in school vehicles, or at any Central Linn School District event both within or outside the District.

Corporal punishment is defined as the willful infliction of, or willfully causing the infliction of, physical pain.

No teacher, administrator, other school personnel or school volunteer, will subject a student to corporal punishment or condone the use of corporal punishment by any person under his/her supervision or control. Permission to administer corporal punishment will not be sought or accepted from any person or agency.

A staff member is authorized and so requested to employ physical restraint when in his/her professional judgement, the physical restraint is necessary to prevent a student from doing harm to others, to himself/herself, or to school district property. The superintendent or designee shall inform all staff members of this policy.
