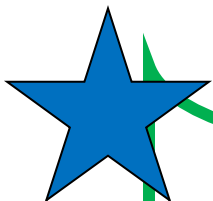

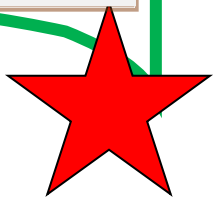

Currently all sports and activities are on hold due to an increase in Covid-19 cases in Linn County and the State of Oregon.

COBRA SPORTS

Central Linn High School sports seasons for this year will be as follows:

- Season 1 ~ 8/31-2/15/21~ Sports permitted based on the Governor's and OHA restriction level for the county.**
- Season 2~ 2/22-4/4/21 ~ Fall Sports (Volleyball, Cross Country, Soccer). Football season will be 2/6-4/4/21**
- Season 3~ 4/5-5/23/21~ Spring Sports (Baseball, Softball, Track).**
- Season 4~ 5/24-6/27/21~ Winter Sports (Wrestling and Basketball).**

Each sport will have 1 week of practice before contests begin, with the exception of football, they will have 3 weeks of practice. Every sport will have one week at the end of the season that is a culminating week. The OSAA has not yet determined what that will look like.

Please keep in mind that these schedules are all subject to cancellations due to the state and county Covid-19 restrictions that are in place when it is time for seasons to start.

ALL ATHLETES that are planning to participate in a sport needs to get their Orange Card paperwork completed and turned to the office before practice starts for any sport.

FYI~ Central Linn School District has decided not to charge Athletic Participation Fees to any athlete that is currently enrolled at CLHS or CLES. If you are not enrolled with CL please call the office for the participation fee amount per sport. There are no scholarships available for this year.
