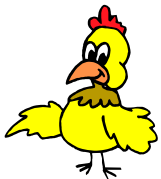

Thank you to everyone who helped with Clean-Up day!

On Thursday April 20th, Central Linn Elementary held its annual clean-up, community service day. CLES students, staff and high school mentors worked at various sites in the district. Most kiddos worked at CLES, where they planted hundreds of annuals, pulled weeds, and spread approximately 25 yards of bark. Each class decorated at least two paver stones that were incorporated in to a path that leads to our kindergarten garden.

Our fourth grade class worked at Halsey City Hall and the post office just north of CLES. They too, spread bark, pulled weeds and planted flowers. First and sixth graders, under the supervision of CLES staff and High School FFA and leadership classes, worked at CLHS. Bark, plants and weeds were the order of business there, too. Kids also cleaned up the football stadium and track area. Thanks go out to Ag teacher, Katharine Smith and leadership teacher, Lindsay Androy.

This project started a few years ago, when CLES administration saw a need to help clean up CLES and to give the kids an opportunity to learn the value of hard work, community service and pride in neighborhood. Our program expanded to Halsey City hall and the Post Office this school year.

This project could not be successful without the support of our great teachers and staff and the contributions of community members. A big thank you to Select Market for donating bags for weeds, J & S supply in Brownsville for potting soil and plants for High School color bowls, and Andy Ridinger and the City of Halsey for tools and bark and welcoming the kiddos.
