The School Board would like to thank all the community members who attended the various public meetings held last month at the Brownsville Baptist Church, Brownsville City Hall, and Halsey City Hall and to thank those entities who opened their spaces for this use. It was greatly appreciated. Board members discussed the history of facilities and past bonds pertaining to the Central Linn School District, clarified questions around the difference between maintenance and capital improvements, and took input from all audience members present who asked excellent questions and gave insightful feedback. Written feedback was collected at the end of each meeting. General themes on feedback forms were the importance of the health and safety of students and buildings, comments expressing the priority of making sure new schools built are built with long-term durability and greatest value for overall cost, and general concern over what will happen if another bond goes out and fails again.

Board members asked those present to start having conversations with their friends and neighbors about the growing needs of the Central Linn facilities. A detailed power point was presented at each forum, and a printed version was handed out to each attendee. Most took their handouts with them, so they could have more time to process the information. Many present thanked the board for this information. Because of this, we have asked the School District to put this PowerPoint on the District's page as a link so that more people may view the information on their own time.
