Attendance

Attendance is very important! Our school wide goal is 96% student attendance and we expect all students to have a minimum of a 90% attendance rate. Any student under 90% may receive an attendance letter. We understand that kids get sick and sometimes miss school for very real reasons. If your child is sick, has a fever, and maybe contagious to other students, please keep them home from school. Otherwise, please help us support your student by making sure they come to school regularly.

School begins at 8:10am. Dismissal is at 3:20pm.

- Morning drop off time is no earlier than 7:45am. Breakfast is served from 7:45am to 8am.
- Morning meeting starts at 8am and ends around 8:05am. Students are considered tardy after 8:10am.
- **If your child rides the bus....** Your child will be escorted by the classroom teacher to load the bus and depart CLES by 3:25pm.
- **If your child is a walker...** Your child will be escorted out of the building and lead to one of three crosswalks that we have staff supervising.
- **If you pick up your child...** Your child will be escorted out of the building to the south side of the building to C Street. Please make sure that when picking up your student, you use C Street as a loading/unloading zone. **Please do not park your vehicle and leave it unattended.** Also, we will require students to use the crosswalks to get to vehicles that are not directly in the loading/unloading zone. Please help us maintain this expectation. If you do wish to park during dismissal times, please use the front or back parking lots to do so. There is no staff supervision after 3:30pm, so we ask that students are on their way home by then!

Bus Notes

Please remember that if your student is going to ride the bus somewhere besides his/her regular stop; a note needs to be sent to the office. If it is a last minute change, please contact the office before **2:30pm**.

Because of time restraints this will start on Sept 20th. Cobra Tales will be sent home with the youngest member of the family unless the office is contact differently. Cobra Tales can be seen on Facebook as well as the Central Linn School District website and can also be sent home by email.

Background Checks required for everyone, every year!

If you have not filled out a background check form this year please stop by the office and get one. Without the background check, you cannot volunteer in the school anywhere or go on field trips.
