**Our third annual Fall Serpentine Parade will be held on Tuesday, October 31<sup>st</sup> at 2pm.**

Starting at 2pm on the 31<sup>st</sup>, each class will parade around the school in a serpentine manner ... as one class passes by, another will join in until all classes are in the parade. The parade will pass through the gym where families and friends can watch. Costumes are optional. If students want to wear a costume, they need to bring it to school, do NOT have them wear it to school. Costumes need to be school appropriate, NO weapons allowed (even play weapons)! Also, please no masks or face painting. After the parade students will return to their classrooms.

**All parents and families are invited to come and enjoy the parade**

As required by law, we do fire drills every month. We also practice Lock In and Lock Down and Earthquake drills. On Monday, we practiced all three. This month students and teachers were aware of when the drill was scheduled, however, that is not always the case. Please talk with you student about how and why it is important to have emergency drills.

A **Lock In** is used when there is a perceived threat in the area outside the school (This maybe even if the threat is in Albany). If the Linn County Sheriff's office notifies us of a threat, we will immediately go into Lock In. In this mode, all exterior doors will be secured and no one is allowed in or out. Classes will continue as normal within the building. Movement is allowed with in the building.

A **Lock Down** is used when there is a threat inside the building. All exterior and interior doors will be secured. There is NO movement allowed. No one is allowed in or out until an all clear is called.

We don't want to alarm students but we do want to practice being prepared, so in case we need it, everyone will be safe! In case of a real emergency, the school will notify parents.
