Reminder:

Please do not park on the south side of the school. There will be permanent no parking signs installed soon. It is okay to sit and wait in your car for your student to come out of the school to you.

If you park across the street, please remember to walk across and greet your student and then escort them back across the crosswalk to your car.

We are committed to safety first for all of our students.

The Character Trait/ Value for the month of September is Respect. The first week we focused on the definition of Respect, the second week on how we show respect to others, and last week on how we show respect to our school and this week how we show respect to our community. Ask your student what they have learned about respect this month. Next month we will be focusing on Empathy.

School begins at 8:10am. Dismissal is at 3:20pm.

- Morning drop off time is no earlier than 7:45am. Breakfast is served from 7:45am to 8am.
- Students are considered tardy after 8:10am.
- **If your child rides the bus....** Your child will be escorted by the classroom teacher to load the bus and depart CLES by 3:25pm.
- **If your child is a walker...** Your child will be escorted out of the building and lead to one of three crosswalks that we have staff supervising.
- **If you pick up your child...** Your child will be escorted out of the building to the south side of the building to C Street. Please make sure that when picking up your student, you use C Street as a loading/unloading zone. **Please do not park your vehicle and leave it unattended.** Also, we will require students to use the crosswalks to get to vehicles that are not directly in the loading/unloading zone. Please help us maintain this expectation. If you wish to park during dismissal times, please use the front or back parking lots to do so. There is no staff supervision after 3:30pm, so we ask that students are on their way home by then!

Bus Notes

Please remember that if your student is going to ride the bus somewhere besides his/her regular stop; a note needs to be sent to the office. If it is a last minute change, please contact the office before **2:30pm**.
