SWIM DAY

To celebrate the end of a great school year, we're planning a special swimming trip. On **June 12th**, kinder students will get their feet wet at Swanson Cool Pool in Albany. While on **June 4th**, students in grades 1-5 will go to Otter Beach in Corvallis. We decided to split these groups to give our youngest future swimmers a smaller, less crowded (and potentially overwhelming) experience. To help make the day a success, we're looking for the following support:

1. **Permission slips** (return to school **no later than June 3rd**)
2. **Snack and drink.** Students will eat lunch before they board buses. Each class will have snacks and water provided. Teachers will distribute them at the pool.
3. **Swimming suits + regular school clothes.** Students can come to school already wearing their suits (under school clothes). Students will have a chance to change if necessary.

A limited number of parent chaperones. The pools are both staffed with highly qualified lifeguards. Too many extra adults around the pool may obstruct the lifeguards' view. Our entire school staff will be at the pool. Parents check with classroom teachers if you would like to chaperone. Space is limited to 1 parent per grade level and males have priority. Parents understand that not all volunteers will be able to go so teachers will notify you.

Thanks for your support. We're excited to be able to make this special trip with our students.

Parental Input Forms for classroom placement for next year are available in the Office. All forms must be turned into the Office by **June 6th, 2019, and will not be accepted after that date.**

Please do NOT request a certain teacher. Instead, please tell us what learning environment works best for your student or what would help your student.

First and foremost, Central Linn Elementary will maintain a balance in each classroom by placing the children according to academic aptitude, gender, and social preferences. Then, parental placement input will be reviewed.
