Registration

Registration is a two-step process. First step will be registering online using the RegiStar program. A letter will be sent home the last week of July with a Parent Id number to use to register returning students. The program will open August 1st for new & returning students.

To finish the registration process, the additional paper forms must be filled out and returned to the school office. These forms will be available on our website or can be picked up during the Back to School Fair.

There will be computers available during Back to School Fair for parents to use. Look for details about Back to School Fair and registration in the letter with the Parent Id number.
