Bus / End of the Day Changes

We have 325 students to get home safely, please keep changes to a minimum to avoid confusion. We are averaging more than 10% of our student body having a change at the end of the day.

Please remember that if your student’s end of the day plan is going to change either by being picked up or riding the bus somewhere besides his/her regular stop; **a note needs to be sent to the office.** If it is a last minute change, **please contact the office before 2:30pm.**

If we do NOT receive a note or phone call students will be sent home via their default plan. If you are unsure of your default plan, please call the office for clarification.

For the safety of all of our students, please do not “grab” your student off the bus. If picking your student up in the lobby, please make contact with the office staff first.

By making contact with a staff member, we are assured that all students make it safely to their destinations.

Thank you for your help and vigilance in keeping our students safe.

Picture day is Wednesday, Oct 16th. Make up and retake pictures will be on Nov. 13th.

Due to technical difficulties with the camera, picture day was rescheduled to **Wednesday, October 16th.** If you sent money in a picture packet with your child, we have secured those packets for you in the office. There will be no need to resend money or fill out a new packet. If you have not yet completed a packet, and you would like to order pictures, you still have time to do so.

5th & 6th Beginning Band

Beginning Band for 5th & 6th grade is after school. Please contact the office one time to add their name to the band list.

Students will ride their normal bus and get off at the High School. They can ride the activity bus home or parents can pick them up.

Attendance is very important! Our school wide goal is 96% student attendance. School wide attendance for September was 95.77%. Any student under 90% may receive an attendance letter. We understand that kids get sick and sometimes miss school for very real reasons. If your child is sick, has a fever, and may be contagious to other students, please keep them home from school. If your child misses school for a medical/ dental appointment please provide the office with a note from the provider. Please help us support your student by making sure they come to school regularly.

Clothing Closet

If your child is still in need of back-to-school necessities, call Audrey at 541-369-2811, ext 2270. She'll help you set up a time to have a shopping experience and find all the things your child needs.

School begins at 8:10am. Dismissal is at 3:20pm.

- Morning drop off time is no earlier than 7:45am. Breakfast is served from 7:45am to 8am.
- Students are considered tardy after 8:10am.
- **If your child rides the bus....** Your child will be escorted by the classroom teacher to load the bus and depart CLES by 3:25pm.
- **If your child is a walker...** Your child will be escorted out of the building and lead to one of three crosswalks that we have staff supervising.
- **If you pick up your child...** Please make sure that when picking up your student, you use C Street as a loading/unloading zone. Your child will be called out of the building after a staff member makes contact with the adult picking them up.
- **Please do not park your vehicle and leave it unattended.** Also, we will require students to use the crosswalks to get to vehicles that are not directly in the loading/unloading zone. Please help us maintain this expectation. If you wish to park during dismissal times, please use the front parking lot to do so. There is no staff supervision after 3:30pm, so we ask that students are on their way home by then!
