Update: The school lunch & breakfast delivery program

- \* March 16, 40 school lunches to 19 families.
- \* As of April 24<sup>th</sup>, CL delivered 208 lunches to 80 families! (These numbers do not include the meals that are picked up at the HS)
- \* Total lunches and breakfasts served ~ 8,134
