Kinder Registration for 2020-2021

Online Kinder registration is open from May 18th to June 18th. And then reopen when general registration opens mid-July.

If you have or know someone who has a child that will be 5 by or on Sept 1st, please pass the word!

To register, please go to the District Website at centrallinn.k12.or.us and click on the Kinder Registration link on the right hand side under Quick Links.

General Registration

General registration will be open mid-July (the exact date TBA) for all students new and returning.

Registration is a two-step process. First step will be registering online using the RegiStar program. A letter will be sent home the end of June with a Parent Id number (PIV) to use to register returning students.

To finish the registration process, the additional paper forms must be filled out and returned to the school office. These forms will be mailed out to families in July.

Preschool

The Halsey Learning Tree Preschool is still taking applications for both classrooms in Halsey. Pre K must be 4 years old by September 1st and potty trained. Preschool must be 3 years old by September 1st and potty trained. We start orientation the week of Labor Day and class the following week. Let me know if you are interested.
