Greetings, students and families!

Wow! What a crazy start to this school year. We are SO GLAD to have your students back with us, whether via distance learning or in-person. Our first day back went amazingly well considering all the changes that have happened!

When you join us this year, please remember students are to enter and exit through their designated entry/exit door. **We will not be entering through the front office door.** Doors around the building are marked with a number and a symbol. First grade enters through the parking lot side door with the “1” on it, second grade through the door on the parking lot side with the “2” on it, third grade through the south side door with the “3” on it, and Kindergarten enters through the back parking lot double doors into the breezeway. Students are to enter and exit these doors (unless vomiting and leaving from the health room) every time they enter and exit the building. If you need to drop your child off late or pick him/her up early, please notify the office and meet a school adult at the designated grade level door.

We have worked very hard to make sure our building and staff are ready for your children while also following all guidelines given by the Oregon Department of Education. You will notice many differences this year. We have marked all floors with six feet spacing, student desks are spaced six feet apart (to the maximum extent possible), every individual is screened upon entry, and many other safety protocols are in place. We take the health and safety of your children very seriously, and we will continue to work hard to give them the best education at the same time.

You will notice a few new faces this year, as three new teachers will be joining the Central Linn family. Tami Lux is our new Special Education teacher, and Shannon Edwards and Amanda Gorton have joined forces in second grade. Each brings with them a love for children and an incredible skill set working with children. Please join us in welcoming them to the Central Linn family!

We had quite the ending to last school year, and this year started off with a bang, as well. Despite all that, however, we will continue to work hard and make this a great and enjoyable year for your child!

Background Checks required for everyone, every year!

If you have not filled out a background check form this year please send a note with your child and ask to have one sent home. Without the background check, you cannot volunteer in the school anywhere or go on field trips.

Please note, we are not currently allowing visitors/volunteers into the building due to COVID, but it is a great idea to have the background check completed for year just in case our world changes for the better!

Attendance is very important!

Our school wide goal is 96% student attendance.

This is for in person instruction as well as online instruction. Attendance is taken every day for every student regardless of how or when they are receiving instruction.

Any student under 90% may receive an attendance letter. We understand that kids get sick and sometimes miss school for very real reasons. If your child is sick, has a fever, and may be contagious to other students, please keep them home from school. Otherwise, please help us support your student by making sure they attend school (online or in person) regularly.

School begins at 8:00am. Dismissal is at 2:00pm.

Morning drop off time is no earlier than 7:55am. Breakfast is served in the classrooms from 7:55am to 8:10am. Students are considered tardy after 8:10am.

If your child rides the bus.... Your child will be escorted by the classroom teacher to load the bus and depart CLES by 2:00pm.

If your child is a walker... Your child will be escorted out of the building and lead to one of three crosswalks. They will be assisted across the crosswalk by a staff member.

If you pick up your child... Your child will be escorted out of the building at their designated exit door. Please make sure that when picking up your student, you meet your child on the sidewalk in front of his/her designated door. Also, we will require students to use the crosswalks to get across the street or to vehicles that are not directly in the loading/unloading zone. Please help us maintain this expectation. We do not have staff supervision after school due to COVID, so please help us ensure that your children are on their way home as soon as school is out. Thank you!
