The USDA will continue their School Meal Program guidelines through Dec 31, 2020. Districts can continue to distribute food to resident children and youth, even though they may not be enrolled in local schools. This means ALL children age 1-18 are eligible for free lunch delivery in the Central Linn School District. If your child rides the bus.... They will be escorted by their teacher to the bus and depart CLES by 2:00pm.

If your child is a walker... Your child will be escorted out of the building and lead to one of three crosswalks and assisted across by a staff member.

If you pick up your child... Your child will be escorted out at their designated exit door. Please meet your child on the sidewalk in front of his/her designated door. We require students to use the crosswalks to get across the street or to vehicles that are not directly in the loading/unloading zone. Please help us maintain this expectation. We do not have staff supervision after school due to COVID, please help us ensure that your children are on their way home as soon as school is out. Thank you!
