Remember, parents, when dropping off your student, you can park in the parking lot, but you need to walk your student across the bus lane to the sidewalk. If you want to drop your student off without getting out of your car, please use the south side drop off. Please do not park your car on the south side, as we have added more buses to the transportation routes. Parking there will block the flow of traffic as well as the buses.

The USDA will continue their School Meal Program guidelines through Dec 31, 2020. Districts can continue to distribute food to resident children and youth, even though they may not be enrolled in local schools. This means ALL children age 1-18 are eligible for free lunch delivery in the Central Linn School District. Since these lunches are **not** income based, EVERY child is eligible. ~ If you are interested in receiving delivery of school lunches, please contact Audrey at 541-973-1890 or audrey.borders@centrallinn.k12.or.us.

School begins at 8:00am. Dismissal is at 2:00pm.

- Morning drop off is no earlier than **7:55am**. Breakfast is served in class from 7:55 to 8:10am. Students are tardy after 8:00am.
- If your child rides the bus....** They will be escorted to the bus and depart CLES by 2:00pm.
- If your child is a walker...** Your child will be escorted out of the building to one of three crosswalks and assisted across by staff.
- If you pick up your child...** Your child will be escorted out at their exit door. Please meet your child on the sidewalk in front of his/her door. We require students to use the crosswalks to cross the street or to vehicles that are not directly in the loading/unloading zone. Please help us maintain this expectation. We do not have after school supervision due to COVID, please help us ensure that your children are on their way home as soon as school is out.
