

NOTICE OF VACANCY FACILITIES TECHNICIAN

The Facilities Technician (custodian/maintenance) will work 40 hours a week and will report to the Director of Facilities. The work schedule has yet to be determined. The beginning hourly wage will be \$14.65 - \$15.01 depending upon experience. Qualifications for this position may include some or all of the following qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Criminal history clearance
- Knowledge of methods, materials, equipment, and tools used in the routine cleaning of school buildings and for maintaining district grounds.
- Knowledge of tools, materials, working practices and methods of the building trades; materials, equipment, working procedure and methods required in a school district building maintenance program, and in the repair and minor construction of school facilities.
- Ability to perform manual labor and work out-of-doors in all seasons as required.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to access computer for directions sent via email or through work order system.
- Ability to read and understand chemical labels/MSDS sheets.
- Ability to maintain simple records.
- Possess or willing to obtain an appropriate chemical applicator's license issued by the State of Oregon.
- Possess Oregon driver's license issued by State Department of Motor Vehicles.
- Ability to develop and maintain cooperative relations with students, supervisors, school administrators, contractors and others contacted in the course of the work.
- Maintain confidentiality in all phases of work, i.e., records, meetings, parents' rights, etc.
