

## SCHOOL BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS MAY 12, 2014



### **SUPERINTENDENT AWARDS:**

Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for May were: Makenna Watson, 4<sup>th</sup> grade; Sarah Isom, 8<sup>th</sup> grade and Grace Wombacher, Senior.

### **ACTION:**

- ▶ Acknowledged staff resignations of John Potwora, Custodian; Jessica Ekegren, Elementary Teacher; Jesse Whiteaker, Jr High Teacher; and leave requests for Laurie McCloskey and Tiffanie Arellano.
- ▶ Approved school board meeting minutes of April 14, and school board work session notes of April 30, 2014.
- ▶ Approved increase in meal prices by ten cents; breakfast and milk by five cents effective September 2014.
- ▶ Accepted the dairy bid from Umpqua Dairy Products for the 2014-2015 school year.
- ▶ Adopted the following school board policies:

- ▶ Approved memorandum of understanding between the district and the classified union to add a new job title of "Facilities Technician". Current maintenance and grounds personnel shall remain under old job descriptions. Current custodians and all new hires shall fall under new job description. The salary shall be the same as "Custodian/Maintenance".

### **BUSINESS:**

- ▶ From the Board work session items of concern were summarized in a listing of Tier 1 and Tier 2 items at both the elementary and high school. Superintendent Gardner was directed to collect cost estimates for the projects as listed.
- ▶ The District is still looking for person to fill the Zone 5 position on the Budget Committee. Interested persons should contact the district office.
- ▶ Board members will complete individually a form for evaluating the superintendent and submit to Susan Beaudin by June 2. A staff survey will also be conducted. Information will be shared with the Board at its June meeting.

### **ADMINISTRATION:**

- ▶ The Bloom N BBQ earned over \$10,000 after expenses.
- ▶ Test scores at the high school are up.
- ▶ District will be receiving increased mental health services for students next year.
- ▶ The District will be contracting with the ESD for TaKeshia Thomas to provide services as Special Education Director.
