COMMUNICATION

- Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for March were: Brylee Johnson, first grade; Saydey Johnson, fourth grade; Lillian Gardner, seventh grade; and Georgia Evans, ninth grade.
- Director Frasier clarified his motion to approve Resolution 16-02-01 at the February 16th meeting. He moved to approve the resolution as submitted with an approximate tax rate of \$1.87 and if the district comes in under, the difference would be returned. What he meant was if the tax rate comes in lower than the estimated \$1.87 the lower tax rate will be charged to the taxpayer.

REPORTS

- Celeste Van Cleave clarified community rumor the District was sitting on an extra \$250,000. The statement is misleading. She explained the unappropriated ending fund balance in the budget was based on State School Funds (SSF) in a 50%/50% split over the biennium. In the current budget you will see the Contingency Fund of \$198,000 to be used as the planned Beginning Fund Balance for 2016-17 and to maintain current programs. These are not extra funds.
