



# CENTRAL LINN SCHOOL BOARD MEETING UPDATE

May 8, 2017

## COMMUNICATION

- Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for May were: Jack Cheney, second grade; Alyssa Greeno, fourth grade; Shelby Simonis, eighth grade; and Hanna Harris, eleventh grade.
- School Board acknowledged student letter regarding the math program at the high school.

## BOARD ACTION

- Declared a school board vacancy for Zone 7.
- Approved meeting minutes of the regular school board meeting of April 10, 2017 as submitted.
- Approved the hire of new math teacher, Mark Watt and second grade teacher, Cassie Bishop, effective August 2017.
- Ratified CLEA licensed employee contract with the district for 2017-2019.
- Approved increasing meal prices by 10 cents next year.
- Directed Administration to move ahead with negotiations with Willamette Neighborhood Housing for the sale of the Brownsville property. It was determined a new appraisal was needed as the previous report did not include the gym which is now included in any sale of the property.

## BUSINESS

- Acknowledged the resignations of Johnna Neal as part-time vo-ag teacher, Casey Jones as education assistant and Jr High wrestling coach, Bob Day. Also, the retirements of bus drivers, Terry McCoy and Rod VanLoon.
- Reviewed as second reading revised School Board Policy IKF, Graduation Requirements.
- Discussed school board led community meetings regarding district facilities. Overall comments were positive and in favor of dome style school. Some concern for moving 6<sup>th</sup> grade students up to the Jr/Sr Campus. Those in favor of a K-12 school sited the opportunity for a better school community and to develop a more caring culture between all students.
