COMMUNICATION

For the Month of November, kindergartner Henley McCord, was the recipient of the Superintendent's Award in recognition of her outstanding personal accomplishments.

The Board will be meeting with OSBA representative, Steve Kelley, at the November Work Session to discuss superintendent search options.

Booster Club was awarded the Linn County Youth Activities Grant for \$30,000. Each JH and HS sport will receive \$1,000 to go towards equipment or uniforms. FFA, OHSET, Band, Choir, Leadership and NHS will also receive \$1,000 to go towards supplies.

A Pixalot Camera system will be installed in the CLHS gym and football field to allow streaming capabilities. The two camera systems were free but the installation will be paid for by the Booster Club.
