Qualifications

The primary purpose of this position is the instruction and supervision of assigned students keeping within the law, board policies, and administrative regulations. Instruction and supervision include student guidance, classroom management, and knowledge in subject areas taught and District standards. This is demonstrated by appropriate curriculum design, instructional practices, and student progress assessments. We anticipate filling one full-time position to teach all areas of math to seventh through twelfth grades. Knowledge and/or experience in proficiency learning would be a major advantage.
