

Info to bring:

- \* Your Social Security number
- \* Your parents' Social Security numbers if you are providing parent information
- \* Your driver's license number, if you have one
- \* Your Alien Registration No., if not a U.S. citizen
- \* Federal tax information or tax returns
  - Use estimated tax information if you haven't filed yet
  - To fill out the 2018-19 FAFSA, you will need 2017 tax Information (yours or your parent's)
- \* Untaxed income (child support rec'd, interest income, vet's non-educ benefits-you or parents)
- \* Cash, savings & checking acct bals; investments, include real estate (not your home) & business assets
