**2/22 ASVAB Test** - The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is the most widely used multiple-aptitude test battery in the world. As an aptitude test, the ASVAB **measures your strengths, weaknesses,** and potential for future success. The ASVAB also **provides you with career information for various occupations in which you might be interested.**

This is a test given by the US Military for no charge. We do not allow any of our scores to be released to the military. If someone wants to do that they need to do it individually. Sophomores through Seniors may take this 1-1/2 hr test, 3 weeks later the testers return and the students return to the computer lab to have their scores interpreted.

4/2 ACT for Juniors – The school district is hosting the ACT test for all of our juniors. It will last from approximately 8 am until 12 pm. The ACT assessment measures high school students' general educational development and their capability to complete college-level work with the [multiple choice](#) tests covering four skill areas: English, mathematics, reading, and science. Colleges use the ACT and the SAT because there are substantial differences in funding, curricula, grading, and difficulty among U.S. secondary schools. Some school districts use the ACT to assess the student learning and/or the performance of their own school, requiring all high school students to take the ACT regardless of whether they are college bound.
